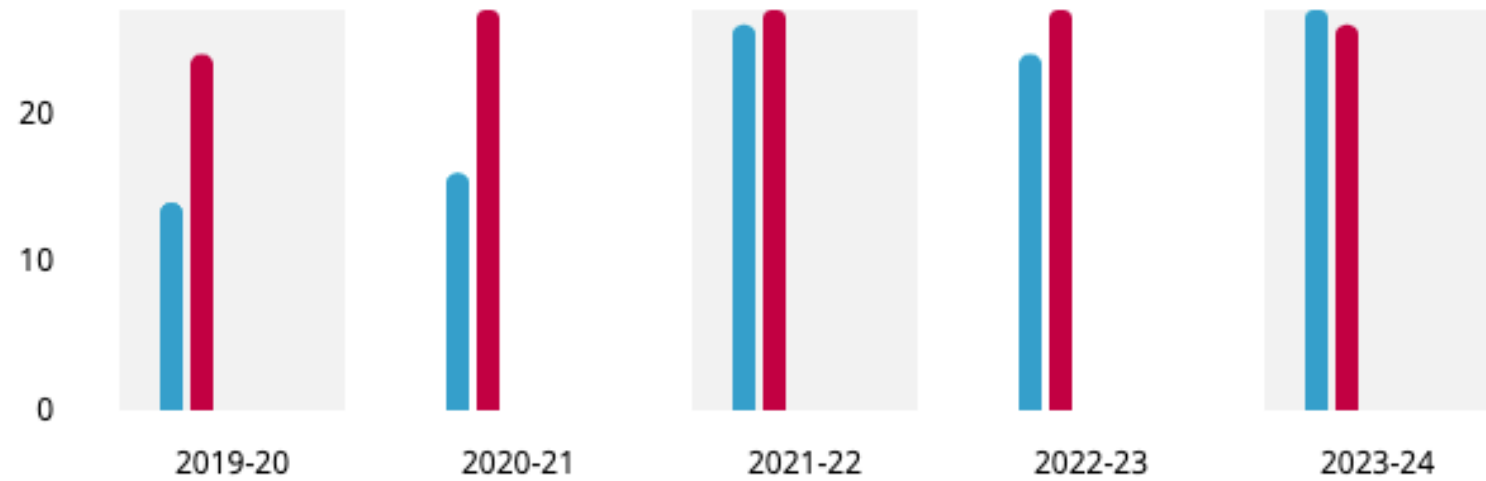

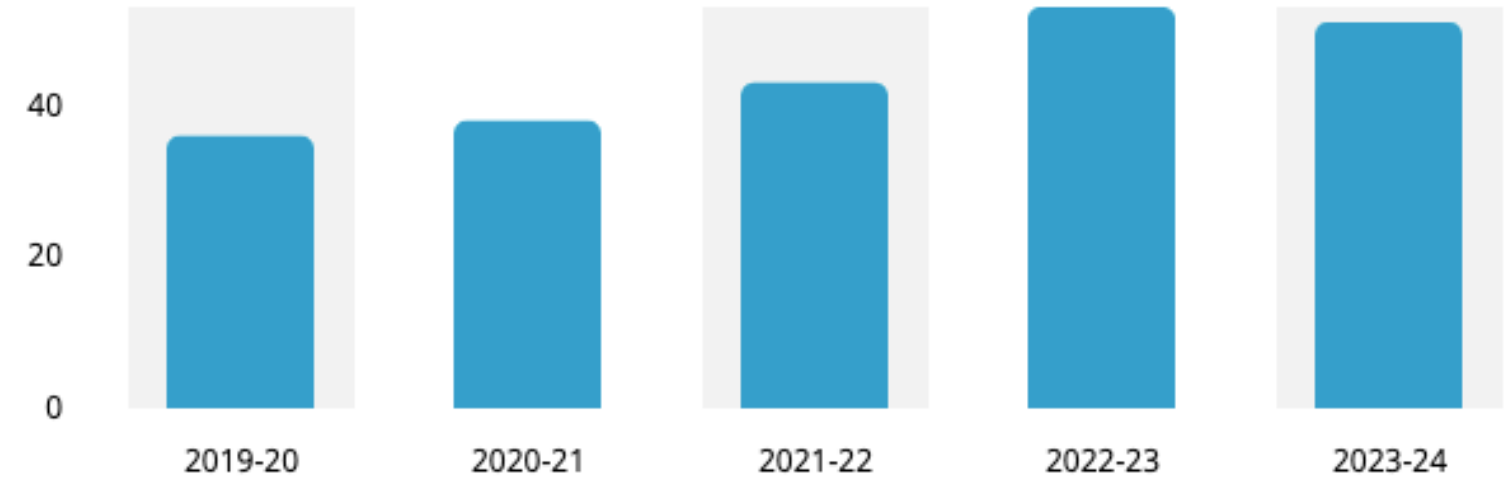

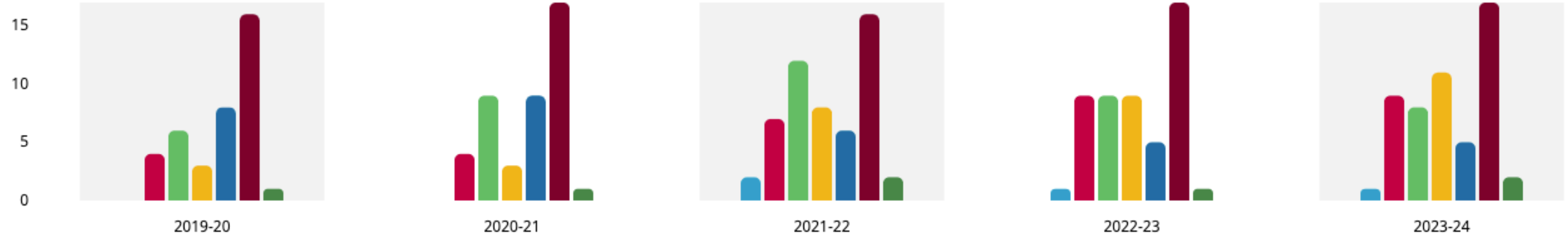

Working bimonthly with NC MedAssist and The Diaper Bank.

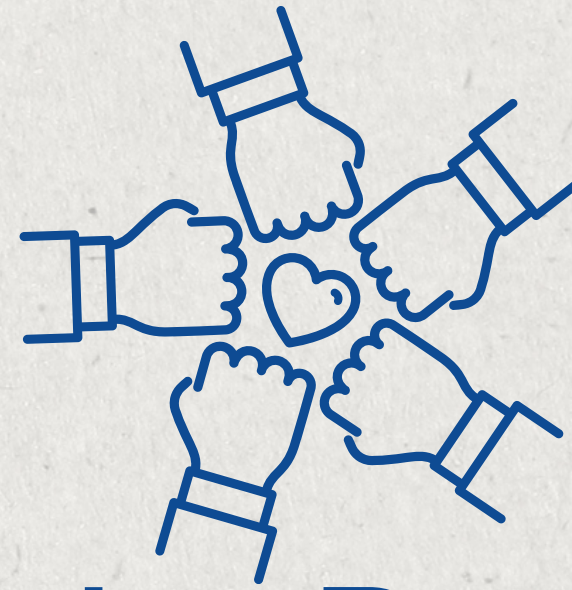
Continuing to work on Party in the Park.

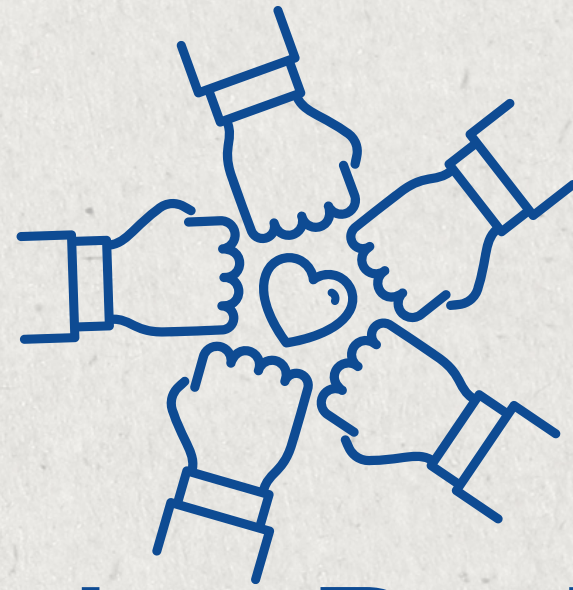

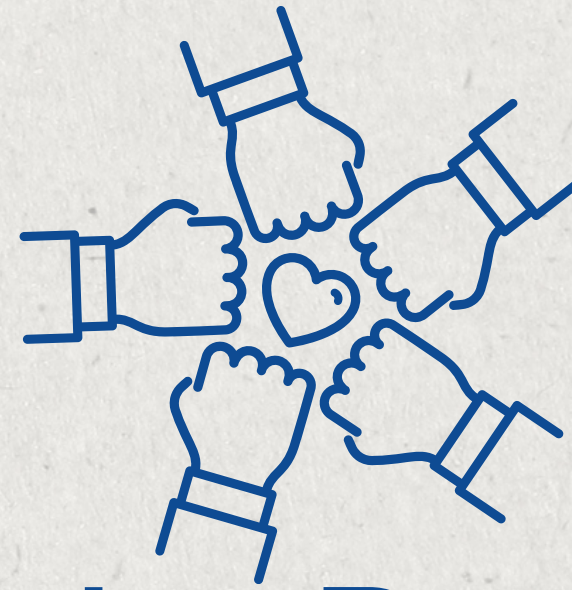
Service Project: NC MedAssist





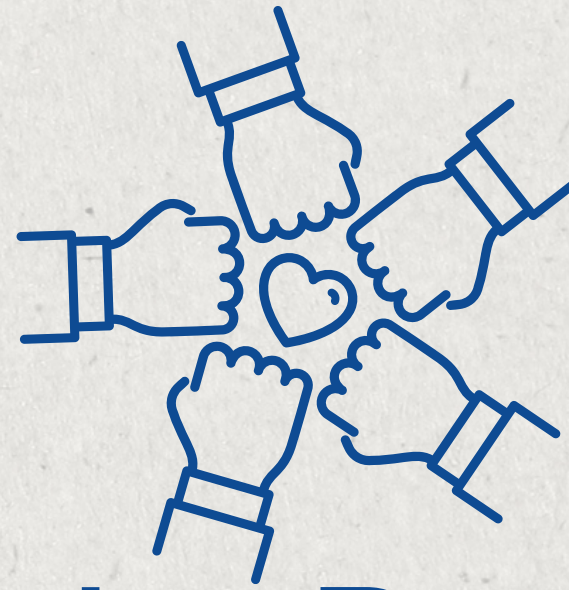
Service Project: Diaper Bank

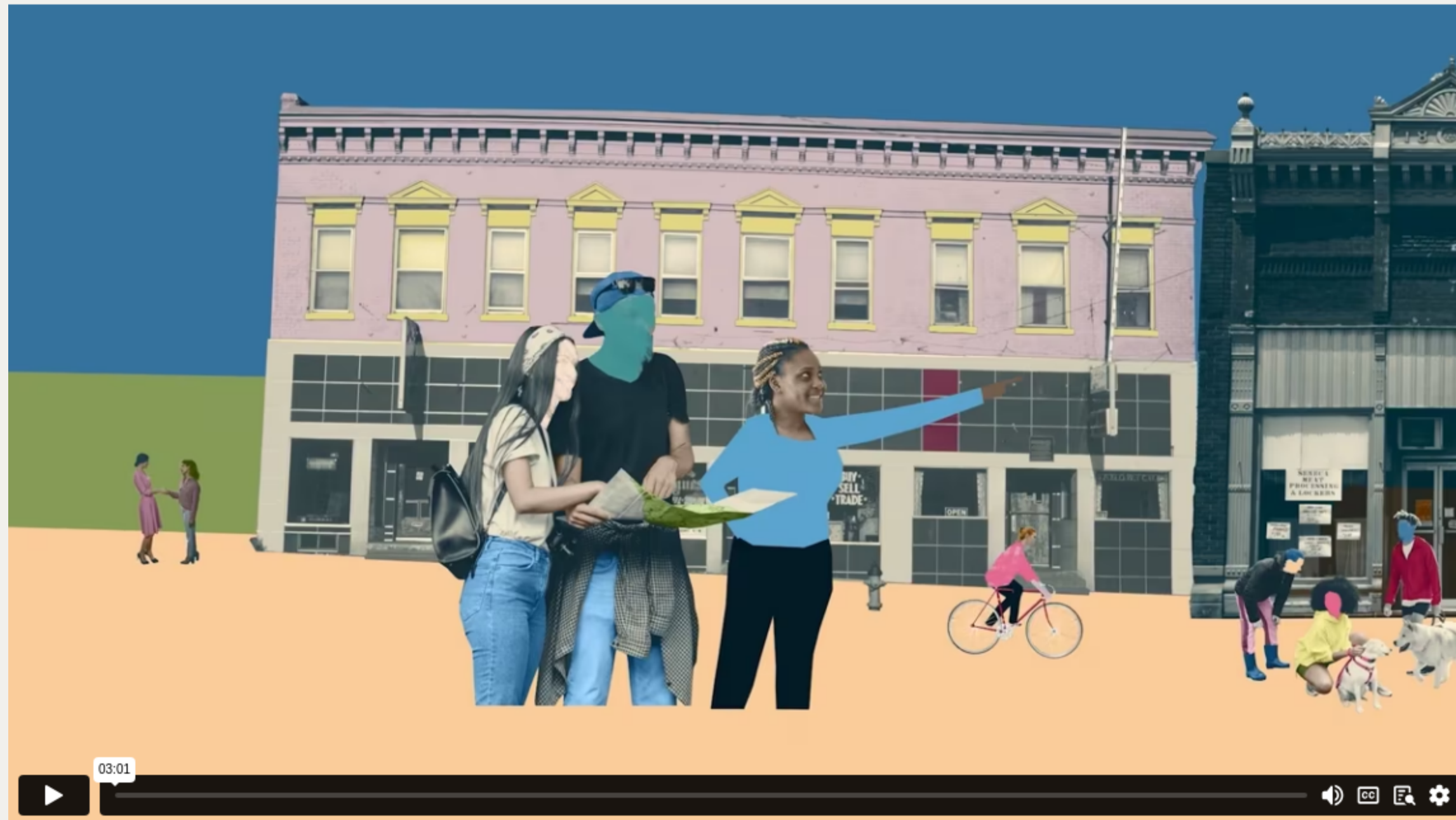
